Role of a Team Manager with Bondi Phoenix

TEAM LIAISON:

The Team Manager is the all-important link between Players/Parents and the Coach/Club

BEFORE EACH GAME:

- Inform the team of that week's match time and venue (court number)
- · Check that all players are available and inform the coach of anyone who isn't.

Create a fruit/Lolly roster for the team. Only quick to eat items during the game please!

ON GAME DAY: SCORECARD:

- When we are the "home team" (the first listed team on the Fixtures) it is our team's responsibility to:
 - Pick up the SCORECARD from the middle of the court. They will be in a plastic box that remains on the court all day; &
 - KEEP SCORE for the game (you can be the scorer yourself or allocate the role to another). You normally stand in the middle of the court with someone from the other team. If you do not, keep your own score & double check with the other person at regular intervals.
- When the other team is the home team, the Team Manager (or an allocated person) usually stands with the other team's manager during the game to verify the scorecard is accurate.
- Every game the Team Manager must ensure that ALL PLAYERS, UMPIRES,
 COACHES and TEAM MANAGERS (& any fill-ins) have signed the scorecard before it is returned to RNA.
 - FYI RNA is strict about this and the team can lose competition points if this is not done.
- · At the end of the game, please **take a photo** of **both sides** of the scorecard
 - o For NETSETGO RNA asks that each player's positions played be noted too
- The WINNING TEAM returns the score-card to the RNA CONTROL ROOM after the game.

GENERAL:

- · Help encourage other parents to support the team without coaching from the sidelines.
- Help the other parents appreciate that the coach has the difficult task of looking after the interests of all the players (not just one player) and also has to balance the needs of the individuals against the needs of the team.
- Get help from Bondi Phoenix or RNA officials if there are any issues either on court or on the sidelines.

Additional Notes for Team Scorer

- Stand in the middle of the court with the scorer from the other team (please make sure you do this as we have had incidents in the past where the score kept by the other team was different to the score kept by us but because we were not standing with the official scorer for that game, their score had to stand).
- The person who is the official scorer must mark the centre passes in case the umpires disagree on the next centre pass (as they will appeal to you for the official decision).
- Team Scorer/Manager signs the score-card at the end of the game to verify the result.


Example Scorecard for Winter 2023 (subject to slight alteration)

For Seniors, Inters, Juniors

These scorecards will have the player's names printed in the left column. The player should sign their FULL Name. E.g. not E King but Elizabeth King.

Strike through the numbers with a / when a goal is scored. At the end of each quarter circle the score for each team and put that number underneath in the Q1/2/3/Total box.

Take a photo of the first scorecard used as this is the card that will be used to compare signatures.



Net Set Go

Again the girls' names should be printed on the form already. You will just need to record where they play in each quarter.

Girls do NOT need to sign the sheet but coach/Umpire/scorer & captain will (ignore timers).

You do NOT need to record the goals/goal attempts in the middle section, just the overall goals. There is a score kept but there is no ladder for this age group. This information will help RNA to grade teams next year when they go into full rules netball.
